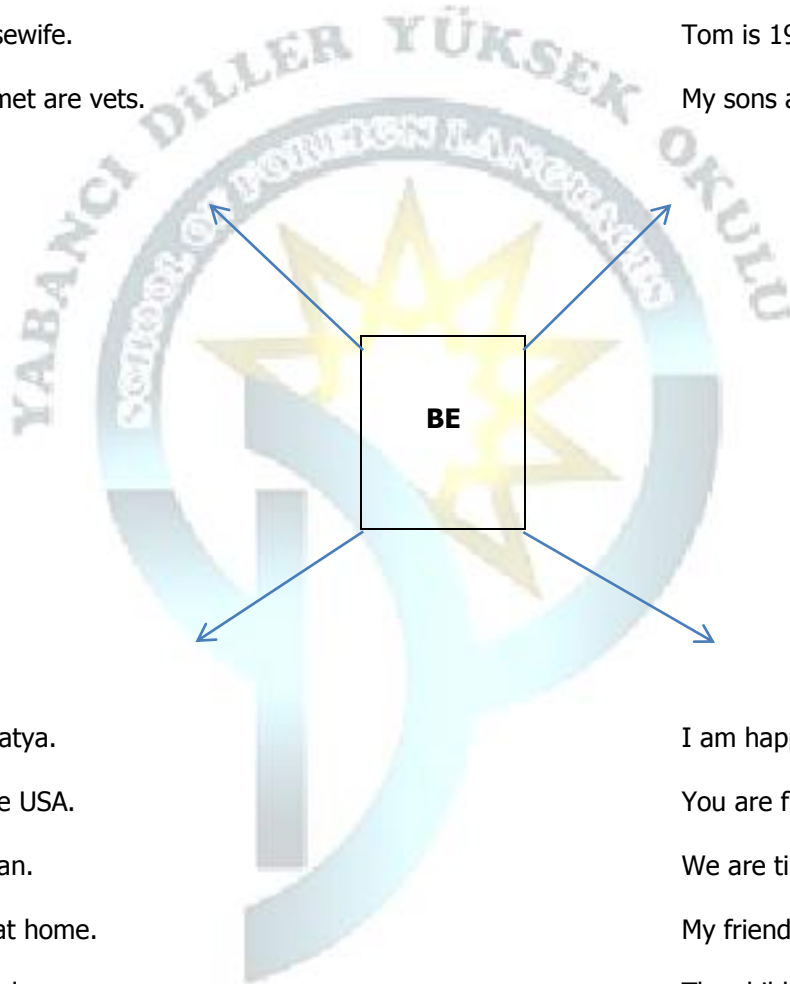

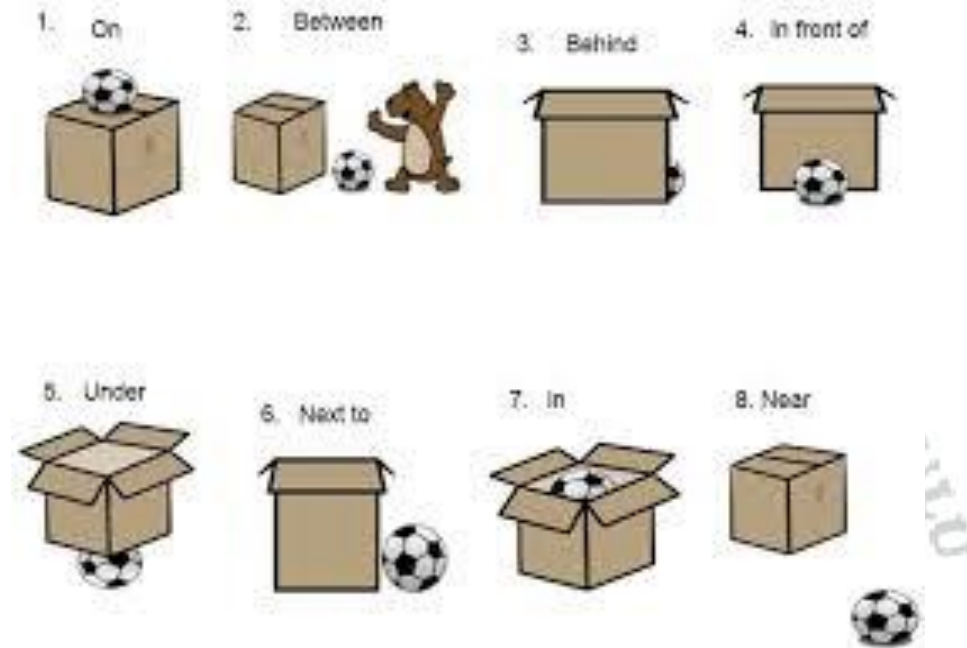

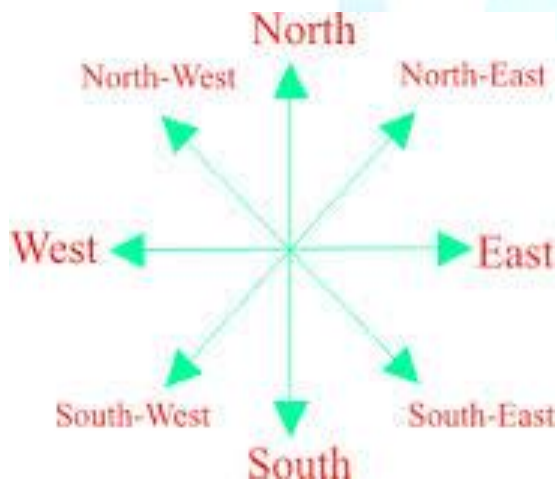

Name: Simon Says School of English

The Simon Says School of English is in Cardiff, the capital of Wales. There are fourteen classrooms and a canteen for students. There is an Internet cafés. The big tourist attractions are Cardiff Castle, the Millennium Stadium in the city centre and the beautiful Welsh countryside.

Name: Partridge Tree English School

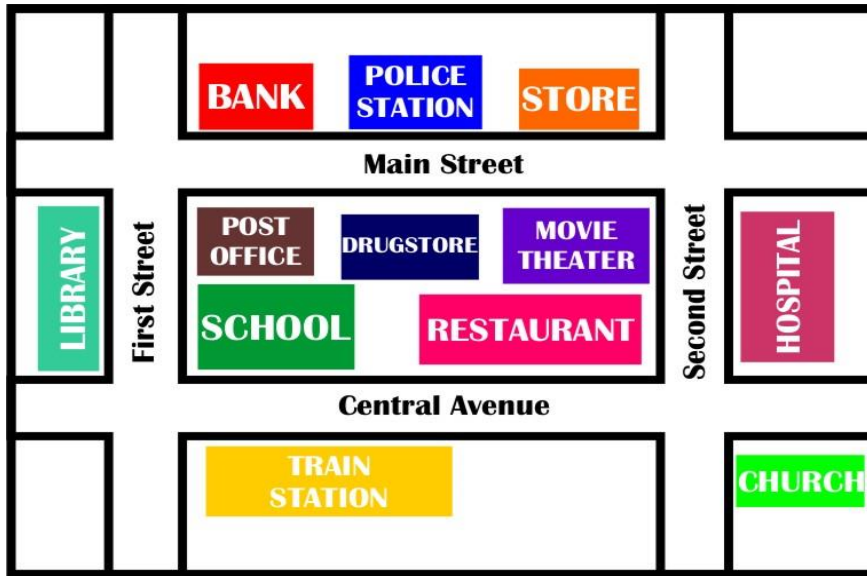
